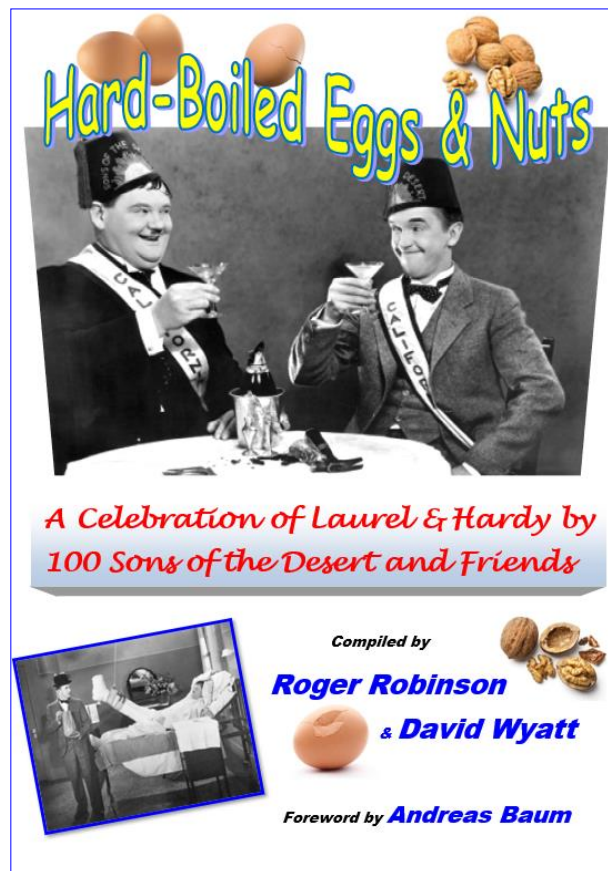


100 Years of Laurel & Hardy
